Sub: Request to grant approval for recovery of FPPPA

Dear Sir,

The incremental FPPPA for Q1 FY 2023-24 for TPL-D(Dahej) works out to Rs. 1.95 per kWh in addition to base FPPPA. Certificate of Auditor for FPPPA for Q1 FY 23-24 is enclosed at Annexure-A.

It may kindly be noted that the power purchase prices have remained higher during Q1 of FY 2023-24. Further there is unrecovered FPPPA of about Rs 1.37 per kWh for the past period. Therefore, it is imperative to consider the corresponding increase in FPPPA for timely recovery of Power Purchase Cost.

In view of above, we request Hon'ble Commission to allow recovery of FPPPA at Rs. 3.35 per unit from Billing Month of July 2023 considering the interest of all stakeholders.


